




# **Pro Mold Bolt On Cushion Edge Models: PMCE**

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#### Introduction

Thank you for your purchase of a Gared Sports model PMCE backstop pad set. To ensure that our equipment will provide years of use to you, we are including this installation guide. This guide will provide information on the proper assembly and installation method for your pad set.

Please note that a Bill of Materials is being included with this guide. Please check that all the parts called out on the Bill of Materials are present prior to beginning assembly and setup. Please do not substitute for factory parts. Please contact the Gared Sports customer service department and allow them to determine if substitute parts are acceptable.

It is recommended that an individual who has been properly trained perform assembly and set up of the PMCE. No one under the age of 18 should attempt assembly or installation of this pad set, unless properly supervised.

If items are found to be nonconforming, replacements can be ordered from Gared Sports or one of our authorized dealers. When contacting Gared Sports, please have information regarding the dealer/installer who sold the product, the name of the project if applicable, and any applicable warranty information.





Before proceeding with assembly, **read all instructions and assembly procedures**. Make sure all parts have been received and are not damaged.

### Parts Checklist

Verify all parts listed on packing list are present prior to installation.

4	Whiz nut	1/4-20 whiz nut	16
5	Connecting rod	6mm Connection Rod	4


#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Tools Required: 5#16" drill bit Portable Drill Tape Measure Center Punch Hammer Utility Knife Masking Tape Marker

#### **Mounting instructions:**

### NOTE: If using a board with existing mounting holes, skip to step 9

1. Use 5/16" drill bit to drill through four rear mounting holes only. This will allow for marking in future steps.











2. Using a tape measure, mark a line on the center of the board




3. Place one pad on the backboard, making sure to fully seat foam against board frame on the bottom and side. Trim foam (if needed) to ensure the center line is aligned with edge of foam.






# 4. Use masking tape to hold the pad in position while fitting second pad.






6. Repeat step 3 with second pad. **NOTE: It may be necessary to trim the pad for proper fit**.








7. Mark the center of the holes on frame




8. Remove the tape and pads. Center-punch the center of hole marks, then drill each hole with a 5#16" drill. Ensure that you do not drill through glass!








9. Select the 1" or 3" bolts (depending on your backboard thickness) and bolt the first pad in place. Insert the connection rods, then slide the second pad onto the rods and bolt into place.













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
